## Camp Upgrades Have Started

A week after campers departed, we started on 2001 improvements, to be continued until next June 2001. New porches were constructed on Cabins 6 & 8. They are both pressure treated lumber, nice and level and easy to see at night. A new kitchen porch was erected, too. All the HOPS (Cabins 8, 7&9, 5&6, 3 and kitchen) were gutted. New toilets and sinks have been installed, new tongue-and-

groove paneling has been put on the walls and a gray tile floor is being placed in each one. You will love 'em next year. Five new R5 kayaks have been added to the fleet (complete with holding racks), all the canoes have been repaired with two new aluminum canoes and a cedar strip canoe purchased. A new sunfish sailboat (equipped for racing) graces the water. The welded structure to "sail on land" is in place and will be a great sailing teaching aid for next summer. We purchased 5 new Dunlop Incline, front and rear suspension bikes to add to the stock as well as another 5 smaller framed bikes for cabin 8 size guys. Now everyone can ride the Chikopi Trail. We also got a new racing K-2, two K-1's and two C-1's. We will be all set for the Regattas next year. There is more, too, but we will wait for the next Newsletter to be sure they are done.
