Camp Clothing is available in all sizes at the camp store. The boys will have the opportunity to purchase camp baseball caps, sweatshirts, swim caps, etc. The cost will be deducted from their camp store account. Clothing will be available for parents to purchase on the day of arrival and departure.

Stamps: Stamps and phone-cards are sold at the camp store. Please note: only Canadian-issued stamps may be used in Canada.

Note: It is very important to put your sons name on absolutely **every thing** that he brings to camp, not just clothing. It is our only means of recognition for lost items.

Note: The camp store sells all the toilet articles that your son may run out of while at camp.

Note: Rental will only be provided if selected on the Registration Form.

Note: Due to our concerns for the environment we request that campers refrain from the use of aerosol cans.

Life Jacket and Water shoes are mandatory when using a water craft.

Your son will do several running exercises at Chikopi please ensure he packs appropriate running shoes.

The Do's And Don'ts Of Packing For Camp

1. Please use the packing list as a guideline.
2. It is important your child's name is on absolutely everything he brings to camp, including; the clothing he wears for the journey to camp, all socks, shoes, underwear, towels, books, cameras, luggage, etc. Please Do Not use initials. It is our only means of identification if an item is misplaced on camp or off camp. Items left behind at camp will be put in storage and returned the following year the camper returns to Chikopi.
3. Be sure your child has clothing to cover all weather conditions.
4. **Proper running and water shoes are extremely important.**
5. Involve your child in his packing, he will be better able to recognize his personal property if misplaced at camp.
6. Avoid sending "favourite items", or expensive articles or belongings.
7. We reserve the right to check luggage.
8. Chikopi does not accept responsibility for any item brought to camp that is lost or broken while at Chikopi or during travel.
9. Chikopi has an on site safe, we recommend that all passports, wallets, and any valuables be placed in the safe on arrival.

Unacceptable Items To Bring To Camp Chikopi

- Knives, Slingshots or electric razors
- Inappropriate clothing (Reference to profanity or drugs)
- Matches, lighters, fireworks,
- Cell phones or pagers (they will not work at Chikopi)
- Squirt Guns
- Any food product containing nuts or has a written warning about nuts
- No homemade food items
- No chewing gum

The following Items Are An Automatic Dismissal From Chikopi

- Drug Paraphernalia
- Cigarettes, Alcohol, Non-prescription Medications
- Pornographic Materials
- Any Item Brought To Camp With The Intention Of Threatening Or Intimidating A Camper Or Staff Member
