

# Arrival and Departure at Pearson International Airport (YYZ)

Our number one goal is to ensure the entire camp experience is amazing for your son which includes his arrival and departure. To assist you with the booking process here are some things you should know before you book your son's flight:

- **Campers arrival.**  
Parents and guardians must book their child's flight to Pearson International Airport (YYZ). Their arrival must be on the session's start date and arrive between the times of 10am and 3pm.  
*\*We do make exceptions for International campers who have only one arrival option please contact the office for flight approval before you book the flight.*
- **We have representatives.**  
Immigration, Customs and Baggage claim typically takes at least one hour. A Camp Chikopi representative will meet your child at Pearson International Airport (YYZ) when he exits the baggage claim area. From here, our representative will take him to a waiting area. The boys are supervised at all times throughout the wait.
- **Unaccompanied minors.**  
If your child is travelling as an unaccompanied minor, please check the box on the Travel Form. Our camp representative will meet your son and the Airline representative. Your son will join the other campers at the hotel.
- **We travel to camp together.**  
Once all of the campers arrive, the vehicle will take staff and campers the three and a half hours north to Camp Chikopi. From there the campers will proceed to have their best summer ever.

## Departure on the last day of Camp

Everyone dreads the end of camp after an amazing summer, but when the time comes it's important to know what comes next. On the last day of their session, campers who have booked transport to Toronto will take the **9am** camp transport. They will arrive at Pearson International Airport at 12.30pm. Flights must depart after 3.00pm and before 8pm. Representatives will be there to help each camper check in their luggage, and assist with all the airport procedures for their flight home. Staff members stay at the airport until the last flight has departed. Make sure your camper has their booking reference #, has paid for or has a credit card for baggage and travel fees and we'll take care of the rest! Pearson International airport no longer accepts cash for baggage and travel fees at check in, please pre-load a credit/debit card for you son.
