**Camp Clothing** is available to purchase in all sizes at the camp store. The cost will be deducted from their pre-paid camp tuck shop account.

**Stamps:** Postage Stamps are sold at the camp store. Canadian-issued stamps must be used in Canada.

- Clothing should be washable, light, and require NO ironing. It is very important to put your son's name on absolutely **everything** he brings to camp, not just clothing. It is our only means of recognition for "lost" items. Laundry is done every week, so please do not pack excessive amounts of clothing.
- Rental will only be provided if selected on the Registration Form.
- Due to our concerns for the environment we request that campers refrain from the use of aerosol cans.
- Life Jacket, whistle and Water shoes are mandatory when using a water craft.
- Your son will do running exercises at Chikopi please ensure he packs appropriate running shoes.

## The Do's And Don'ts Of Packing For Camp

1. Please use the packing list as a guideline, remembering that we do laundry once a week.
2. It is important your child's name is on absolutely everything he brings to camp, including; the clothing he wears for the journey to camp, every sock, shoe, underwear, towels, books, cameras, luggage, etc. Please Do Not use initials. It is our only means of identification if an item is misplaced on or off camp. Personal property left behind at camp will be donated to Charity. We have many years experience on labeling clothing, a Sharpie works best.
3. Be sure your child has clothing to cover all weather conditions.
4. Proper running shoes – to avoid injuries.
5. Proper water shoes are extremely important. Example: <http://www.walmart.com/tp/water-shoes>
6. Involve your child in his packing, it will help him recognize his personal property if misplaced at camp.
7. Avoid sending "favourite items", or expensive articles or belongings.
8. We reserve the right to check luggage on arrival and or departure at camp.
9. Chikopi does not accept responsibility for any item brought to camp that is lost or broken while at Chikopi or during travel.
10. Chikopi has an on site safe, we recommend that all passports, wallets, and valuables be placed in the safe on arrival.

## Unacceptable Items to Bring to Camp Chikopi

- Knives, Slingshots or electric razors
- Inappropriate clothing (Reference to profanity, violence or drugs)
- Matches, lighters, fireworks
- Cell phones, wifi/wireless/satellite devices.
- Squirt Guns
- Food/Gum

## The following Items are an Automatic Dismissal from Chikopi

- Drug Paraphernalia
- Cigarettes, Alcohol, Non-prescription Medications
- Pornographic Materials
- Any Item Brought to Camp with the Intention of Threatening or Intimidating a Camper or Staff Member
